Dear Mr. Wallack:

The Department of State Police ("Department") has received and reviewed your request for Department records. The Department considers your request as a submission pursuant to G.L. c. 66, §10, the Massachusetts Public Records Law. The Department is denying your request for the reasons stated more fully below.

As to your request for any reports that were "completed into the shooting of [an identified individual]", the Department has determined that information pertaining to the investigation and prosecution of the Boston Marathon bombing and its aftermath are not subject to public release pursuant to G.L. c. 4, §7, cl. 26 (f) (investigative exemption). According to information provided to this office by the Middlesex District Attorney's Office, the records you seek pertain to an open criminal prosecution pending in Middlesex Superior Court. In light of the status of this matter, the report(s) you seek are not subject to public disclosure at this time pursuant to G.L. c. 4, §7, cl. 26 (f) (investigative exemption).


As to the remaining portion of your request, please be advised that the records you seek pertain to an on-going internal investigation being conducted by the Department into the events of the Boston Marathon bombing and its aftermath. In light of the pendency of this investigation, the record(s) you seek are not subject to public

disclosure at this time pursuant to G.L. c. 4, §7, cl. 26 (f)
(investigatory exemption).
